With easy access to Amtrak, light rail, subway, buses, and the major thoroughfares of I-83, I-95, and I-295, Midtown is the district that links the entire city. As both the geographical and cultural heart of Baltimore, no other district boasts as many museums, art galleries, concert halls, or unique shops. Offering many main attractions including the Walters Art Museum, the Washington Monument, and Baltimore Symphony Orchestra. The area is also a focal point for education, home of several renowned institutions such as Johns Hopkins University, Maryland Institute College of Art, and The University of Baltimore. Centrally located right outside Penn Station and just off of I-83, Orange Barrel Media's massive digital asset reaches the wide Midtown audience as well as crowds heading Downtown.

Penn Station

As the eighth-busiest rail station in the country, Penn Station is Baltimore's main transportation hub, with passengers arriving directly from Washington DC, Philadelphia, and New York City for an Orioles game, business meeting, or a weekend getaway.

Pimlico Race Course

As Baltimore's premier destination for horse racing, Pimlico welcomes over 120,000 visitors per year and is home of the Preakness Stakes, the second largest race in North America.

University of Baltimore

Located just down the street from OBM's digital asset, University of Baltimore is one of Maryland's finest public universities, with a total enrollment of almost 5,000 undergraduate and graduate students.

Maryland Institute College of Art





DOWNTOWN

BUSTLING URBAN CORE

Downtown Baltimore is experiencing a renaissance mixing historic architecture and landmarks with modern upgrades, drawing professionals in banking, power, and health care to redefine the Central Business District. With the live venues in Bromo Arts District, endless attractions along Inner Harbor's waterfront, and high-end shopping in Harbor East, Downtown is a bustling mix of restaurants, outdoor activities, shops, and nightlife. Crowds gather for sporting events and concerts at nearby Oriole Park at Camden Yards (home of MLB's Orioles), M&T Bank Stadium (home of NFL's Ravens), and the Baltimore Convention Center. Orange Barrel Media's seven full-motion digital spectaculars are the first and only digital screens in the center of the action along Baltimore's multi-lane one-way arteries that connect Downtown, allowing marketers to connect with a diverse audience.

Oriole Park at Camden Yards

For more than 30 years, Oriole Park has been home to MLB's Baltimore Orioles, with a capacity of 48, 876 and host to big-name concerts, festivals, and community events.

M&T Bank Stadium

Located next to Oriole Park, this 71,000-seat stadium is home to NFL's Ravens and has been an exciting venue for Premier League soccer, NCAA Lacrosse, and popular performing artists.

Baltimore Convention Center

Drawing over 500,000 people to attend over 125 events per year, the Baltimore Convention Center is buzzing with activity year-round.

National Aquarium


With an annual attendance of 1.3 million, this world-renowned aquarium has over 20,000 specimens and is one of Baltimore's main attractions as it aims to inspire aquatic wildlife conservation.

University of Maryland, Baltimore (UMB) Medical Center

UMB educates over 7,000 students at six nationally ranked professional programs in dentistry, law, medicine, pharmacy, nursing, and social work.

CFG Bank Arena

This state-of-the-art, 13,000-seat indoor arena is new in 2023, hosting a range of events from CIAA Basketball Tournament to big-name concerts.

- In a vibrant area crowded with business professionals, families, visitors, and sports fans, hustling between nearby attractions, restaurants, parking, hotels, and endless activities along the waterfront with boat tours, museums, festivals, and concert venues

- · This unit faces westbound traffic flowing down the oneway corridor, E Pratt St, wrapping around its corner to guarantee visibility to both vehicles and the bustling foot traffic that swarms this waterfront pier and its surrounding attractions. Our digital wallscape is visible across the open plaza at the National Aquarium down to Baltimore's World Trade Center and the Harborplace mall
- The Power Plant itself is unforgettable with its striking brick and terracotta facade. Notable occupants include Phillips Seafood with its packed outdoor patio, the Hard Rock Café, and Barnes & Noble


